- Meet at least one of the following criteria:
 - o Be registered as a local government elector for the town.
 - Have occupied, as owner or tenant, any land or other premises in the town for the last 12 months.
 - Have your principal or only place of work in the town for the last 12 months.
 - Have lived in the town or within 3 miles of its boundary for the last 12 months.
