



## Customer Suggestion Log.

- A few people have raised the question of zebra crossings in Bexhill – they have said there is not enough of them.
- It has also been raised that a zebra crossing on Buckhurst Road could help with the school crossings.
- wanted to suggest a pelican crossing by the station for children to cross, said grandson almost got knocked over by a car as drivers do not see or stop at the zebra crossing.
- wanted to request a crossing by Bridge Road for children to cross, said the road is dangerous to cross currently.
- More Litter and Dog poo bins around – **Pebsham, Old Town, Hastings Road** area (College students walk this route, busy route with litter and lots of dog poo, as this area also has lots of alleyways, dog poo being left in bags on trees as not enough bins around)
- More litter and Dog poo bins along the **Promenade** and along the **Sea Front**. This has been raised several times by different people.
- Community Recycle bins on sea front (like Eastbourne)
- Pedestrianize **Western Road** and **Devonshire Road** - said this has been done in Shoreham and worthing and is much better – town is busier etc. Wanted to suggest this be investigated please.
- Disabled Toilet Keys – A few people have asked for these from The Hub – Currently collected from Town Hall.
- Clock Tower at West Parade – can the illuminated clock be solar powered? To save money and be more environmentally friendly.
- Trees planted along the streets.
- Flower Beds on the front to be planted again.

- wanted to suggest speed bumps along **Dorset road** as he had his car written on and so did his neighbour by trying to come out of their driveway in Dorset road - the gentleman said cars go too fast up and down this road. It is a busy road with the college and school run route, **Both halves of Dorset road** - road is separated by the bypass (by college and st Richards school)
- 30mph signage along **Cooden Drive** – Larger signs and more of them.
- More seating in Bexhill – not enough seating for people to rest on. Mainly on the **sea front** and at **Ravenside**.
- BT Phone boxes, fixed, cleaned, as are in a mess.
- Dropped Curb on **Richmond Road**, no dropped curbs on this road, makes it difficult for people using mobility aids to get on and off the pavement.
- Multi story car park – maybe where Sainsburys is – said the town needs a bigger car park to attract visitors as the town is dying.
- Trees planted back in **Albany road** – said they were taken away by council and they would like them back.
- Wanted to know if the development of the sports centre / climbing wall expansion can be investigated again – said the town needs this, the application got to stage 1 and did not go further. Said the town needs something for youngsters to do.
- Fountains on sea front fixed – suggested that the water company pays for this as an apology for allowing sewage into the sea.
- Crossing near / by **The Sackville** – road is dangerous with speeding cars, cars come round the corners quickly, making it feel unsafe to cross the road as cannot always see the traffic due to parked cars, and traffic goes too fast in this area to cross safely.
- A new speed limit of 20mph on **Collington Lane West** – This road has no footpaths, and the cars speed up and down this road, making it dangerous for pedestrians – especially elderly and children / parents with pushchairs.
- Speed deterrents down **Cooden Drive** cars speed down this road, it is a straight road and dangerous, needs a speed deterrent – camera, or speed guns or something to slow down the cars.
- Larger speed signs down **Cooden Drive** - current signs are too small and people do not see them or pay attention to them.

- Speed camera or speed gun on **Turkey Road** – cars speed along this road and make it difficult and dangerous for residents to get in and out of their driveways.
- Free Multistorey car park within Bexhill town, to make parking better and encourage more visitors to the town.
- **Western Road** to be made into a 20-mph road, as there are lots of disabled parking and people crossing the road, many cars speed up this road.
- Parking issue in **Herbrand walk**. People parking on the double yellow lines causing issues along this road – double yellow lines are covered in beach stones and are not always visible.
- Was not happy about the bus article in the paper last month (August) - said there is no late buses to **St. Stephens ward** - said last but is ten to two number 97. Asked why some wards are covered with the new bus times and others have been missed.
- Keep the Recycling bins in the town – and not close them down. The town needs public bins (**Sainsburys Car Park**)
